

MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

<u>School Supplies:</u> We ask that each student bring the following supplies for their personal use. These items can be purchased through the SHPA PTA School Supply Kit program or shopped for at a local store.

- To order supplies via the SHPA PTA School Supply Kit program, order no later than July 9.
- Go to <u>educational products.com/shoppacks</u> and enter the Richfield Campus school ID: SHP000 (3 letters, and 3 numbers).
- Follow the directions to complete your order and keep your online confirmation as your receipt.
- Keep in mind that sales tax and shipping will be applied at checkout. Remember that each kit will be shipped to your home. Do not enter the school address as your shipping address.

Whether you order the kit online, or shop for the items below on your own, please bring the supplies to Back-to-School night in late August or pack them in the student's backpack to bring on the first day of school.

<u>Community Supplies:</u> We ask that each student bring the following supplies for their classrooms and shared spaces. Please, give these items to your advisor.

- 4 pack of Expo markers (black <u>or</u> multi-colored packs)
- 1 box of facial tissue

<u>Personal Supplies:</u> We ask that each student bring the following supplies for their personal use. These items should be organized and kept in the student's locker.

- Pencils
- Black or Blue Pens
- Highlighters (4 different colors)
- Small handheld pencil sharpener
- Pencil case
- Basic calculator
- Two-Pocket Folder (4)
- Art Sketchbook: 4x6 or similar with at least 50 pages
- Binder index dividers (12): plastic style preferred
- College ruled single subject notebooks (8)
- Purchase one set of the following based on student preference:
 - o Large Binders (2) students will use one for their morning classes and one for afternoon classes. If you order the kit per the instructions above, this option will be included in the kit.

<u>PE Reminders:</u> Students may change out of their uniform for PE classes, but we ask that students wear shorts or pants of appropriate length. Students may not wear black soled shoes during PE class. We have found it beneficial for students to keep a stick of deodorant in their lockers.
